MISSOURI VALLEY SWIMMING, INC. (on behalf of and as agent for USA Swimming, Inc.) has approved the application to hold the above listed amateur swimming events, under the following requirements and conditions as listed in the current edition of the ***USA Swimming Rules and Regulations*** and the current rules and regulations of Missouri Valley Swimming, Inc. (“MVS”).

**Conditions of Approval:**

1. All of the requirements of Articles 202.2 and 202.4 of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations as well as all other USA Swimming, Inc. and Missouri Valley Swimming, Inc. Rules and Regulations shall be complied with and enforced.
2. This Approval is non-transferable.
3. In granting this approval, it is understood and agreed that **USA Swimming, Inc.** and **Missouri Valley Swimming, Inc.** shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

- 4 Total Fees for this Approval are \$30, \$15 for the Sanction Application Fee and \$15 for the Sanction. If these fees are not paid herein, they must be made to the MVS Treasurer, whose address is at the bottom of the next page, within 21 days of the date of this approval, or this approval shall be VOID. **Fees have not been paid.**
- 5 A sufficient number of USA Swimming officials, certified by their LSC, must be present, permitted on the deck and be allowed to observe and certify that the conduct of competition and all times achieved in such competition comply with all applicable USA Swimming technical rules, including, but not limited to: all of Article 101 (*Start, individual stroke and relay rules*); 102.2.2 & 3 (*limiting swimmers to a specified number of events per day*); 101.1.3 (*false start rule*); 102.16.4A(1) & (2) (*requirements for official time/performance*); 102.16.4 B & C (*timing resolution*); as well as the following facilities rules: 103.2.3 (*minimum depth for racing starts*), 103.3.1 (*length of racing course*), 103.4 (*racing course walls*), 103.12 (*starting platforms*), 103.14 (*backstroke lines and flags*).
- 6 Swimmers shall be limited to five (5) events per day.
- 7 A sufficient number of USA Swimming officials is defined as including the following: 1. A USA Swimming Referee; 2. A USA Swimming Starter; 3. At least two USA Swimming Stroke and Turn Judges, at least one of whom must be stationed at each end of the pool during all periods of swimming competition.
- 8 Timing must be accomplished by at least two (2) timers per lane, unless fully automatic timing is used, in which case, one timer per lane may be used.
- 9 The Official Meet Results must be mailed to all clubs attending the meet, together with one copy mailed to the Missouri Valley Swimming Office, at the address below, not later than 21 days following the conclusion of the meet. If this meet uses Hy-Tek Meet Manager, then, in addition, the MVS Office must receive a disk containing an additional copy of meet results as follows: **the meet host using Meet Manager should click on file, then click on export. then click on Results for Team Manager which is the first choice. This creates a cl 2 file. This brings up an Export Results window, make the appropriate selections for sex, teams etc and then click ok. This is the file that MUST be exported to MVS. Coaches like to get a backup of meet manager for their use. THIS IS NOT THE FILE TO EXPORT TO THE OFFICE. YOU MUST INCLUDE A HEADER FOR ALL PRINTING DONE WITH THIS MEET DISK. THAT HEADER MUST INCLUDE THE SANCTION NUMBER FOR THE MEET AS LISTED ABOVE.**
- 10 If you are fully using USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, you must use the USA Swimming Championship Meet “whistle” starting procedure, as contained in §101.1.2A of the USA Swimming Rules.
- 11 If you are fully using USA Swimming Rules and Regulations to govern this meet, you must use the “No Recall” starting procedure, as contained in §101.1.3 of the USA Swimming Rules.

**12** There needs to be included in your meet announcement the following: **Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.**
